

Notice of Public Comment Period



Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973

Notice is hereby given that the City of Urbana is conducting a self-evaluation of all City-owned pedestrian rights-of-way and facilities for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Title II of the ADA requires that each of the City's services, programs, and activities be readily accessible and usable by individuals with disabilities.

The City is soliciting public input and comments from individuals with disabilities, their caregivers, and disability advocates, on what barriers exist or are perceived to exist in the City of Urbana's services, programs, activities, and/or pedestrian rights-of-way (i.e. sidewalks and curb ramps). This comment period will be an opportunity to provide suggestions and comments on how to remove barriers. All comments will be reviewed and considered for inclusion in the City's self-evaluation and transition plan.

Public comments may be dropped off in writing or mailed to Clay Miller, ADA Coordinator, 205 S. Main Street, Urbana, OH 43078 during normal business hours or provided via email to clay.miller@ci.urbana.oh.us. In order for comments to be considered for the transition plan, comments will be accepted until 4pm Friday, May 31st, 2019. However, the City of Urbana is always looking to improve any barriers; additional comments are always welcomed.

The City of Urbana complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act. Upon request, the City will provide written materials in appropriate alternative formats, or disability-related modification or accommodation, including auxiliary aids or services, to enable individuals with disabilities to participate in public input.
