# URBANA CITY COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, DECEMBER 20, 2016

President Marty Hess called the regular meeting of the Urbana City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. City staff attending: Mayor Bill Bean, Director of Administration Kerry Brugger, Director of Finance Chris Boettcher, Director of Law Breanne Parcels, City Engineer Tyler Bumbalough, Water Reclamation Facility Superintendent Chad Hall, and Community Development Director, Doug Crabill.

**PRESIDENT CALLED ROLL:** Doug Hoffman, present; Tony Pena, present; Pat Thackery, present; Ray Piper, present; Dwight Paul, present; Cledis Scott, present; and Gene Fields, present.

President Hess led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MINUTES** of the regular session meeting of December 6, 2016, in addition to Work Session Minutes of December 6, 2016, were presented for approval. Mr. Paul moved for the approval of minutes and Mr. Thackery seconded. Voice vote on approval: all ayes; nays, none. Motion carried without objection.

#### COMMUNICATIONS:

1. Oak Dale Cemetery Board Meeting Minutes of September 29, 2016, and October 20, 2016. Mr. Thackery moved to accept all communications together and Mr. Pena seconded. Voice vote on approval: all ayes; nays, none.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS – BOARD OF CONTROL:

#### 1. EJP - \$7,673.49 (Sewer Fund)

Mr. Fields moved to authorize a purchase order for the purchase of heating cable and fiberglass insulation for the repair of digester sludge feed lines. Mr. Thackery seconded. Voice vote on approval: all ayes; nays, none. Motion passed 7-0.

# 2. Trenor Motors - \$10,000.00 (Capital Improvement – Cemetery)

He also remarked that 2016 has been a busy year and he anticipates 2017 to be just as busy or even busier.

Mayor Bean spoke of the Ohio Municipal League meeting he attended in Columbus, and some discussion of that meeting consisted of the efforts of the State of trying to free up some money to help municipalities. He also touched on the Stormwater Utility project and stated that another City in Ohio, Bucyrus specifically, has enacted a Stormwater Utility in the amount of \$7.00 per month for residents. He stated that he was advised by Bucyrus representatives, that it has freed up a lot of

money. Mayor Bean thanked Council for their support throughout 2016. He also spoke of his interest of getting the Roundabout safe, and that he feels very strongly about this issue. Mayor Bean also wished everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.
