- Planting or removing tree(s) in the public right-of-way prohibited without approved permit.
- Trees chosen from the preferred tree list only as recommended by the <a href="Shade Tree Commission">Shade Tree Commission</a>. List is located on the City website.
- The City reserves the right to remove trees within the right-of-way when it deems necessary.
- Large and medium trees are preferable as street trees with appropriate tree lawn widths of 8 feet minimum for large trees and 6 feet minimum for medium trees.
- Spacing of new street trees: 60 feet between large trees, 40 feet between medium trees.
- Trees must be: 15 feet from signs, driveways and fire hydrants; 40 feet from overhead power/electric lines for medium trees; 60 feet from overhead power/electric lines for large trees.
- Street trees planted at least 10 feet from underground utilities.

## **Applicant's Affidavit**

The undersigned hereby applies for a permit to plant and/or remove tree and/or stump, within the right-of-way herein located and described. The undersigned states that he/she is well informed on Chapter 905 of the City of Urbana Tree Ordinance and guarantees that all work and material will meet or exceed the minimum requirements of that Code. Ohio Utilities Protection Service (Ohio 811) must be called at least 48 hours prior to permit submission in order for Engineering to inspect the planned planting location for adherence to the utility setbacks. Phone number is 800-362-2764 or 811. OUPS must also be contacted for stump removal. Permit holder must call the City Engineer's Office within 5 days of completion of the permitted work for a compliance inspection. He/she also understands that if a permit is issued, it shall remain in force for six calendar months. He/she certifies that the information contained herein including attachments is correct to the best of his/her knowledge. The undersigned understands that knowingly falsifying this information may be grounds for the denial or revoking of this application and subsequent approval thereof.
